MINUTES OF THE SUBCOMMITTEE ON FACILITIES, MAINTENANCE & SCHOOL  
BUILDING

PRESENT: JACK NOBREGA, MARLENE POLLOCK

ABSENT: JILL USSACH

The meeting convened at 6:32 pm.

The first item of business was a review of the Facilities Work Order Reports for the months of March through September, 2010.

A motion was made by Marlene Pollock and seconded by Jack Nobrega to receive and place on file the Facilities Reports for the months of March through September 2010.

Under new business, a request was made to address the Sub Committee regarding signage for the high school gymnasium. Mr. Nobrega stated that he spoke with Mike Shea, Superintendent of Greater New Bedford Regional Vocational Technical High School, to request they build a sign to identify the location of the gymnasium on the grass area at New Bedford High School.

Mr. Nobrega and another vendor will look into placing signage for the Beardsworth-Gonsalves Gymnasium. Mr. Nobrega noted that he would cover the cost of signage.

Under other business, Marlene Pollock asked about the status of the Ottiwell School with discussion of the Pregnant and Parenting Teens (PPT) Program possibly going into the building. Ms. Pollock asked Mr. Oliveira to look into the issue.

Dr. Francis arrived at the meeting and stated that Adult Ed did not want to go into the Ottiwell building.

Ms. Pollock stated that the Feast of the Blessed Sacrament Committee is interested in the building.

Dr. Francis stated that Ottiwell would need to comply with regulations in order to be able to house the PPT Program.

Mr. Nobrega then asked about the status of the Phillips Avenue School.

A motion was made by Marlene Pollock and seconded by Jack Nobrega to declare Phillips Avenue School surplus and turn over to the City for their usage. Motion passed to the full School Committee for discussion.

Mr. Gilly Safioleas arrived and inquired about signage of the Beardsworth-Gonsalves Gymnasium. The School Committee voted to have this done in May of 2009.

Mr. Nobrega said he would inquire about placing signage on the gym entrance.

There being no further business, the Sub-Committee voted to adjourn at 7:00 pm on a motion by Marlene Pollock and seconded by Jack Nobrega.
